I did not have time to read it all. Did the report point out that exposure to Smartmeter is an "involuntary exposure" in nature. This is not like using cell phone which is a personal choice. Exposure to Smartmeter is imposed upon consumers. The risk tolerance threshold should be much lower for involuntary exposures.
